
2. Click the Get Started Button and follow the prompts.


Adding a Non-Family Member

- 1. Go to WikiTree.com and log in to your account.
- 2. At the top of the page, hover over the "Add" tab in the main menu bar.
- 3. From the dropdown menu, click on "New Person".
- 4. This opens the form where you can create a new profile for someone not yet on WikiTree—such as a parent, grandparent, sibling, or someone from your research.


For an easier way to create your source citiations

#1 WikiTree Sourcer

1. After you install the WikiTree Sourcer Extension from the Chrome Web Store, look at the top-right corner of your browser.

You'll see a puzzle piece icon that's where all your browser extensions live.

- 2. Click the WikiTree Sourcer
- 3. Select one of 4 build options
- 4. Paste to your profile





#3 The Hard Way

- 1. Locate the Source You're Using
- 2. View the Record Not Just the Image
 - Click "View Record" this displays the transcription or details.
 - Let Do not click "View Image" unless needed for verification. Many citations won't copy correctly from the image viewer.







#3 The Hard Way

3. Copy the Citation

- Most databases offer a "Source Citation" or "Cite this Record" tool.
 - On Ancestry, scroll down to "Source Citation" and copy the full text below Detail.
 - On FamilySearch, look for the "Cite this Record" section.
- 4. Go to the Person's WikiTree Profile
 - Click the "Edit" tab on the person's profile.
- 5. Click Edit Biography/Text





#3 The Hard Way

- 6. Add the Citation Text
 - Paste your copied source citation.
- 7. Click "Preview" and Check Your Work
- 8. Enter or select Change Explanation





Review Matches for Duplication

When you create a new profile on WikiTree, the system automatically checks for existing profiles with the same or similar name, birth and death dates, and locations to help prevent duplication.

If no potential duplicates are found, you will be directed to continue creating the new profile. You can then proceed to enter the individual's biographical details, add stickers or categories, and paste source citations. Once the information is complete, you can save the profile by clicking the "Save Changes" or "Update Changes" button.

This process ensures each individual added to WikiTree is unique, while maintaining the collaborative integrity of the shared family tree.







Add Categories and Stickers

Add A Category to a Profile

- 1. Go to the profile page of the person you're editing.
- 2. Click the "Edit" tab at the top of the profile.
- 3. In the Biography editing box, at the very top before == Biography ==, type the category using this format:

```
[[Category:Example Category Name]]
```

For example, to add someone to the U.S. Black Heritage Project category, you would write:

[[Category:US Black Heritage Project]]

- 4. You can add multiple categories—just place each on a new line above the biography section.
- 5. Scroll down and click the "Save Changes" button (or "Save Draft" if you're not ready to publish yet).







How to Add a Sticker

Step 1: Go to the Profile

- Open the WikiTree profile where you want to add the sticker.
- Click the "Edit" tab.

Step 2: Locate the == Biography == Section

- Scroll down until you see the section header == Biography ==.
- Place your cursor immediately below this line and hit the spacebar once.

Add Sticker Code: Step 3

Step 3: Add the Sticker Code You can type it manually or use the Sticker Helper tool:

A. Manual Method (if you know the code)

Example: For African American heritage:

```
{{African-American Sticker}}
{{US Civil War Sticker}}
{{Slavery Sticker}}
{{US Black Heritage Project Sticker}}
```



Using the Template Helper (for any sticker) The Template Helper (also called the Sticker Helper) is built into WikiTree — you do not need to download an extension.



Add Sticker Code: Step 4 – 5

Step 4: Click "Preview"

• Check how the sticker appears at the top of the Biography section.

Step 5: Save the Profile

Once satisfied, click either:


- "Save Draft" if you're not finished editing.
- "Full Save" if you're ready to publish your updates.
